SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- For a learner to qualify to offer Mathematics in Grade 10, a pass mark of 50% in Grade 9 is necessary in the final exam and not as a **report mark**.
- For a learner to qualify to offer Accounting in Grade 10, a pass mark of 50% in Grade 9 Mathematics & EMS is necessary in the final grade 9 exam and not as a **report mark**.
- Physical Science may not be taken in combination with Mathematical Literacy.
- For a learner to continue to offer Mathematics and in Grades 10, 11 and 12 he/she must maintain a 50% average for the subject per term, as well as achieving 50% in the exam - failing which the learner must offer Mathematical Literacy and can no longer offer Physical Science and will then offer Tourism in place of PS.
- For a learner to continue to offer Accounting and in Grades 10, 11 and 12 he/she must maintain a 50% average for the subject per term, as well as achieving 50% in the exam - failing which the learner must offer Business Studies.
- Please note that additional fees are charged for learners taking **CAT as per the fees document**.
- Only the Deputy of SACPS FET can approve the selection of Mathematics and Accounting in Grade 10 to 12.**
