The Intermediate Phase consists of Grades 4 to 7. There are 12 classes with an average of 28 learners per class. We offer six (6) subjects in the Intermediate Phase for grade 4 to 6 with a sport period for each grade once a week and 9 subjects for Grade 7. Additionally we have a computer period for all Grade 4 to 7 learners as well as robotics and coding classes. Our Educators are qualified to teach each subject in the phase.

Intermediate Phase Robotics forms a large part of the learner's success. We cannot wait for you to join the fun education! Every learner is assisted with remedial support classes and additional lessons to improve the learners' abilities. These are compulsory to ensure learners meet their mile stones.

From a sport perspective we offer soccer, table tennis, netball and volleyball as our main sporting activities. Seasonal sports include athletics, bulletjie rugby, chess and action cricket to name a few.

Apart from the sports activities we also have chess, aerobics, Eisteddfod (presents opportunities to young talent in all communities for participation and displaying their talents in music, dance, theatre and fine arts.), spelling bee, maths club, science club, choir, knitting, debate club conquest Olympiad public speaking.

We take part in the Horizon Math competition in which 60 of our grade 5 to 7 learners usually participate against over 5000 learners in our province in the second round. We also participate in the Natural Science Olympiad under (SAASTA) South African Agency for Science and Technology.

All of the grade 7 learners get a chance to be appointed as Primary School Leaders to help with discipline in the Primary School. The appointment of the leaders, not only improve the learners' leadership skills it also maintains discipline in the Primary School, and gives confidence for daily aspects in their lives.

Each term there are excursions for the learners along with a concert at the end of the year where every learner participates. It's an event not to be missed!!
