SUMMARISED SCHOOL RULES

A PRESCRIBED DRESS CODE

1. Full school uniform must be worn at all time.
2. Pupils must always be neatly dressed and shirts must be tucked in.
3. Girls
 - may only wear small sleeper earrings or studs in their ears. No other studs allowed.
 - dress length may not be more than 8cm above the knee when kneeling.
 - girls hair must be either long or short and no beading or jewels in your hair.
 - no boys grey pants may be worn and no tight pants.
 - no colored nail varnish may be worn or colored hair.
 - girls must wear green socks. **NB White socks and white hair bands only for Grade 12's.**
- Boys
 - no moustaches, beards or jewelry of any kind will be allowed.
 - no hairstyles like mow hawk etc.
 - no skinny pants for boys
 - Boys must wear grey socks

B CLASSES AND LESSONS

4. Pupils must arrive at school and be seated in class by **07H45**.
5. Pupils must always arrive for classes and lessons on time at all times.
6. Movement between classes should be done quickly, quietly and in an orderly fashion.
7. Noise and disorderly behavior in class will not be tolerated.
8. Pupils are not allowed out of class without the teacher's permission and the teacher's lanyard.
9. Pupils are responsible for the neatness and tidiness of their classrooms. There should be no eating or littering in classrooms.
10. Cell phones should be switched off during school hours or they will be confiscated. MP3 players and i-pods will not be tolerated and will also be confiscated.

C SCHOOL GROUNDS

11. No pupil may leave the campus during school hours without the permission of the Principal. Doctor's appointments and other requests to leave the campus during school hours must be accompanied by a letter from the parent, or an email from the parent's email address.
12. No littering on the campus or in the immediate vicinity of the school.
13. No smoking or any harmful substances on the campus. Alcohol is forbidden. No learner is allowed to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
14. No writing on walls or damaging of school property. Parents will be responsible for costs incurred for repairs.
15. Fighting and bullying will not be tolerated.

NB - Pupils found in possession of any drugs or alcohol or under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be summarily expelled.

D EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

16. Sport and cultural activities are compulsory at SA College. The extra curricular form must be completed and returned to school at the beginning of the school year.

E GENERAL

17. The possession and chewing of any kind of gum is prohibited.
18. Teachers, other staff and visitors should be greeted and treated with courtesy and respect.
19. A disciplinary system of merits and demerits exists and will be applied rigorously but fairly.
